

e-LEARNING SAFETY & CONSENT FORM (YEAR 1 & YEAR 2)



There are some things you are expected to agree to in order to keep yourself and others safe when you are using computers, iPads or other digital devices.

1. I will use iPads and other digital devices to help me learn.
2. I will use iPads and other digital devices when I have been asked to by my teacher or other adult.
3. I will only use Internet sites that an adult has organised for me.
4. If I am feeling confused or unsure about anything, I will ask for help.
5. I will not be mean, rude or unkind when using iPads, the Internet, or any other digital device.
6. If I accidentally find anything that is upsetting, mean or rude, I will let a teacher know straight away.
7. I will not use my name or address on the Internet unless an adult is with me.
8. I will take care of all devices by:
 - not eating or drinking near them
 - using them responsibly
 - letting a teacher know if anything is damaged.



USE OF THE INTERNET: Information for Parents and Caregivers

The Internet has become a major source of educationally useful material and an important learning tool. Your child will, at appropriate times, be given access to the Internet as an information source, a communication tool and a publishing medium. We take all reasonable steps to prevent and minimise access to unnecessary or unsafe material. These include:

- Use of a filtered Internet service to block access to sites with unsuitable material.
- Wherever possible all Internet access during school hours is supervised by a staff member.
- Teaching students to use options that help to refine searches e.g. adding 'k12' to find age appropriate sites.
- Educating students about the consequences of accessing or attempting to access inappropriate material or sites.

In the unlikely event that your child either deliberately or accidentally accesses inappropriate material, we will contact you as soon as possible. Your child's wellbeing and safety is of prime importance to us.
